Organisation details

The Bradford Sub Aqua Club is a registered non-profit organisation based in Queensbury, Bradford that's run by its members. The club is an award winning branch of the British Sub Aqua Club (BSAC) and was founded in 1955, making it one of Britain's oldest diving clubs. They are a family friendly dive club, accommodating young children all the way up to senior citizens and cater to all abilities. They offer SCUBA diver training as well as other diving opportunities and have use of two swimming pools (Shipley and Eccleshill) as well as their Clubhouse, based in Queensbury, which serves as a safe space for their members.
