The St Ives Estate in Bingley offers facilities for families to enjoy the outdoors. They have a children's play area, fishing, cafe, woodland walks and sculpture trail.

Challenge Details

As we enter Autumn, the site has over 1,000 weekly visitors and needs help with some general upkeep and maintenance. This is typically done by an ageing team of local volunteers. A team of business volunteers would be able to complete the below much quicker:

- clearing lake overflow
- Trimming shrubberies
- clearing walkways

Number of volunteers

Teams of 5-20 volunteers.

On-site support

On the day Participate will be providing a member of staff to support the volunteers. A trained first aider and first aid kit will be available during the challenge. A tools talk and health and safety briefing will be given by Participate at the beginning of the day. No previous decorating experience is required as training and support will be given on the day.

Preparation

Volunteers participating in this should consider the clothing they wear as paint splashes can spoil clothing, especially gloss. Volunteers should pay particular attention to footwear ensuring it is flat.
