Organisation details

Autism Bricks is a Community Interest Company that uses pre-loved Lego to engage with children and adults with autism. The company processes and sorts Lego parts, builds kits, and sells them online to provide meaningful work experience for adults who may find it hard to learn valuable work-related skills in a safe and familiar environment.

In addition to their work with adults, Autism Bricks also collaborates with SEN schools, providing LEGO enterprise activities for students. With LEGO, students design and create items that they can sell, working out costings, carrying out market research, and finally selling their products at school fairs.

Challenge Details

Volunteers who have supported previous will remember installing shelving for their Lego room. Since that visit the shelving has since been used to their amazing Brick Café in Bingley. Your challenge will be to bring this room back to how it was.

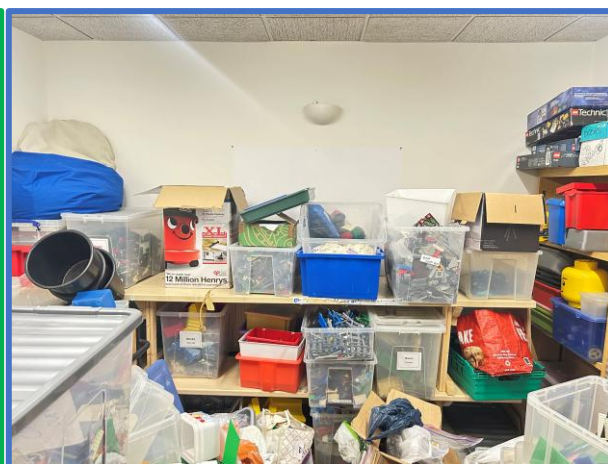
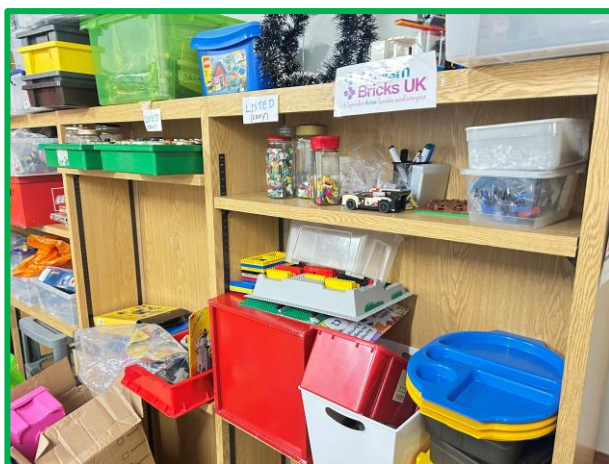
Preparation
